

<b>Brief information about activity</b>	<p>On the occasion of Anandibai Raorane's 28th Commemoration Day, which was on December 8, 2022, the college decided to host two contests. The institution hosted two different kinds of competitions, one of which was a badminton tournament open only to students of the college, and the other was a marathon race at the state level. The Anandibai Marathon-2022 was a state-level competition, and participants came from nine different districts throughout the state of Maharashtra. During this competition, there were a total of 195 participants, 36 of whom were women, and 159 of whom were males. The competition that is being offered is a race over a distance of 5 kilometres, and for preparation for it, each participant in the competition was given a kit and a chase number. Each participant was required to pay a registration fee of Rs. 200/- before they could participate. This tournament got underway at nine in the morning at Sambhaji Chowk, which is located in Vaibhavwadi. This competition was inaugurated by Police Inspector Hon. Amit Yadav, Deputy Tehsildar Mrs. Kaskar madam, Local Management Committee President Hon. Sajjan Kaka Raorane, Hon. Pramodji Raorane and the principal of the college Dr. C. S. Kakade. Pradhan Kirulkar, Akshay Padwal, Omkar Baikar bagged the first, second and third positions respectively in the men's category and Tejashwi Namye, Sonal Yende and Siddi Rawale in the women's category. The contestants in both these groups will get Rs.5000, Rs.3000, Rs.2000 respectively. Prizes, medals and certificates were awarded. <b>Objective of the activity</b>	In order to establish a culture of marathon running in the Kokan region Encourage them to take part and help them be ready for the discipline they will face in the military and the police. promoting healthy living via sporting activities, particularly those that take place outside, encouraging people to run and participate in sports in general among amateurs while also providing opportunities for pros to compete, and encouraging participation in sporting activities, more notably among younger individuals In addition to reinforcing a sense of national unity and educating people about the role sports play in promoting sustainable development and minimising conflict, this activity will also help promote the spirit of national unity.
<b>Outcome of the activity</b>	Tejashwi Namye, Sonal Yende, and Siddi Rawale took first, second, and third place, respectively, in the women's competition, while Pradhan Kirulkar, Akshay Padwal, and Omkar Baikar took first, second, and third place, respectively, in the men's competition. The prize money for the competitors in these two categories will be as follows: 5000, 3000, and 2000 rupees accordingly. There were prizes, medals, and certificates are provided for all winners and participants. These findings demonstrate that gains in physiological capability are connected with increased performance in marathons.
